



Operate and Maintain Chainsaws

- Course:** Operate & Maintain Chainsaws – AHCMOM213
- Duration:** 2 Days – beginning at 8AM
- Location:** Meet at the Hume Weighbridge on Tralee St, Hume (see map below) – take the turn off from the Monaro Highway signposted with Public Weighbridge.
Note: there are two Tralee Streets in Hume that intersect.
- Food:** Please bring morning tea and lunch
- Equipment:** All equipment is provided, however, should you have access to a chainsaw and Personal Protective Equipment (helmet, earmuffs and chaps etc.) please bring it along so we can work with equipment you will use regularly.
- Clothing:** Please ensure you wear work boots and bring clothing appropriate for the day's weather (hat, raincoat, sunscreen).
- Enrolment:** Please bring along your driver licence, Medicare card, birth certificate or passport as proof of ID (1 only required).
- Please also **prior** to commencement of the course obtain your **Unique Student Identifier (USI)** and bring it along to the course.
